About the course

- The BA (Hons) in Primary Education is a new opportunity for teaching assistants who do not have a first degree to become primary school teachers.

Application requirements

Candidates must not already have a university degree. They will also be required to pass an interview, have a letter of support from their school, and have passed two A-levels or equivalent to apply.
